- **3. ACT Scores/Accuplacer Exam**: (for incoming freshman) First year students will need to submit testing scores. If students take the Accuplacer exam, tests scores will be forwarded to the scholarship committee.
- **4. Eligibility**: The Division of Child and Family Services must provide a letter certifying your eligibility for the scholarship. To receive verification of foster care status, please contact Jennifer Larson, Adolescent Services Program Administrator (801) 707-9734 or jblarson@utah.gov
- **5. Letters of Recommendation**: One or more letters of recommendation from someone who knows you and who can address your academic promise, maturity and perseverance (such as a teacher, counselor, caseworker, employer, or foster parent **not a personal friend**)
- **6. Course Plan:** Schedule a meeting with an academic advisor to develop a course plan (or educational plan) showing the courses and semesters you need to complete your degree. This plan must be completed with an advisor and submitted with the scholarship application
